Be sure to meet Participation Requirements for your age group.

We have 2 club shows in the books for 2019! There are many new faces as well as familiar faces this year. We are so glad to have each of you as a member of the WWRC family!

Several changes were made from last year. Those changes included the age group ranges and the addition of 2 new age groups. Another change that occurred was the decision to treat Team Roping events separately. Team Roping events are not included in the 2019 all-around points, instead they are independently tallied and will be awarded their own end-of-year prizes.

All points earned, including team roping, will calculate into the lifetime points total. With that said, open team roping points will NOT be added to lifetime point sheet totals until the end of the season in order to reduce any confusion. This applies ONLY to open team roping. Youth age group team roping points are calculated into the lifetime point totals at the conclusion of each show before point sheets are posted. If you ever see a discrepancy please contact us so that we may review and make corrections if necessary.
